IV. Principal's Update - Dr. Amy Besser, Principal

- Smarter Balanced Assessment begins April 29 English language arts. May 6 will be assessing math, May 13 is the 5th grade assessment for science. This is typically for grades 3-5. Check out coffee with the principal for more updates.
- iReady assessments start May 13-June 5. Students in grades TK-2 have the Dibels end of the year assessment May 13-June 6.
- April no school April 24. Awards assembly April 25. Earth day April 25. April 26 first grade field trip.

V. Teacher Advisor Update - Rachael Suarez, 5th Grade Teacher

 No updates. Happy that open house went well. Excited for Junior Olympics and Earth Day.

VI. President's Report - Rachel Wagner, President

- Applause for Rachel Lewis and April Wish on DPY everyone had a great time.
- We have received insurance for Coach and Savannah as soon as approved by the district. Holding off on Yvonne cuz she is not feeling well and don't know when she will return. Mr Rodriguez has his own insurance so should resume no problem. Lots of crazy rumors going around. The issue is we did not have insurance for ETeam teachers. Oversight for over a decade. Once brought to attention, we took action as fast as we could. ETeam has a responsibility to put a stop to any rumors.
- Besser ETeam "teachers" are not certificated teachers. They are specialists in supporting the credentialed teachers. Commending Rachel and ETeam on how fast we responded. April 5 we first met and insurance has been acquired. Just waiting on district to approve.
- Kyle Porter concerned about how parents were not informed right away about ETeam specialists issue. Wants to have more communication about these issues. Disappointed in the lack of transparency. Besser response several parents have reached out to her about issue. Would like parents to reach out to her directly. Wagner appreciates the concern. Wants to reiterate that we were not sitting on information but there were a lot of moving parts. Could have communicated earlier. Besser those classes did continue even without the specialists. Teachers took over. Porter honesty up front would have been helpful. Rachel Lewis ETeam is always around for concerns. Keeping the issue close may have helped cause less of an uproar. May have helped us solve the issue sooner rather than later. Ellie Sweeney Reminder that all of Eteam are volunteers. Rachel Wagner spent a lot of time working on this and it is so much work. We tried to get the most information we could and did the best we could with the situation. Rachel Wagner we learned of the situation 2 weeks ago. Trying our best.

- Next ETeam board meeting is the transition meeting to next years board. A couple vacancies but if we do not have multiple people interested in a role, we do not need to have a vote. Will approve in May. Will share in newsletter about vacancies. Have 2 vacancies for 4th grade advisors. We are in good shape and have a lot of new parents interested in joining.
- We have a lot of topics to discuss for the next year. Thinking of doing a half day retreat situation to discuss roles with board members.
- Book fair was a success raised \$4162.17. All proceeds from book fair go to library. May want to revisit Book Fair in the future as far as how much is given to school vs. ETeam.
- Junior Olympics ETeam did print and design signage. Kathleen Fong did designs and Ms Whitehead was thrilled.
- Last meeting we were asked by Besser to fund supervision aides. No action was taken
 at that meeting. We wanted to survey the teachers first. We did have some losses this
 year such as enrichment. Will be worse next year because we will need to pay facility
 rental fees from this year and for next. Would be close to \$50,000 for fees. Huge hit to
 budget. We will talk to teachers in person and send a follow up survey. Will share with
 ETeam to see what questions we want to ask. Sent a check in for \$13k for only half a
 semester.
- Insurance for Coach and Savannah for now till end of school is \$1052 for Coach. Savanaah is \$646. That is only for less than 2 months.

VII. Treasurer Report/Financial Update - Ellie Sweeney & Karen Bayless, Co-Treasurers

- Savings \$200,829.65 Checking \$165,491.04.
- Budget hoping to give an accurate update by next meeting. Had to refund some enrichment classes. Now that we have insurance, could we reinstate coach's classes
- Gala is in full swing hoping there will be good fundraising there.
- Do not think we will meet original goals, but we had a crazy year of changes.
- Don't have formal number for DPY profits

VIII. Fundraising - Haylee-Rae Averill & Sanaz Jedian, Co-VP Fundraising

- DPY was a great event
- Next big event is gala lots of people involved. Going to be very fun. Invites went out today. Basket needs went out. Hope all the grades are buying items.
- We need parent party donations could be anything such as kidnapping the kids in PJs and going to breakfast.
- Lewis and Wish want to thank everyone who helped out with DPY. Hard part is getting people to volunteer. We were mostly manpower by teenagers who needed service house. Should probably work on getting the kids who need hours to help out and not as many parents. Wish disagrees because we have so many parents at the school who could help. Lewis says having more events that are community driven might be helpful for future participation. Hamburger Planet was great with getting food out fast. Wagner agrees with more community driven events.
- Back to Gala paddle raise what will gala be asking for? Can make a decision when talking to teachers. Might be the smart boards but could also be supervision aides.
 Besser believes manpower is more important at this point in time. Suarez thinks we will have to ask all the teachers. Sometimes fundraising for aids is difficult because parents expect to receive supervision but items could be easier to raise money for.

- Getting started with teacher appreciation have some new ideas coming through. It is the week of gala. Will be getting information out about it soon.
- Enrichment has a lot of headache at the moment with trying to figure everything out. Coaches classes had 42 students. About half have asked for refund and 6 have decided to take a different class. Deadline is today to respond about what they want to do about the class. Unfortunately Mr R's employees are not available to cover Coach's classes.
- Teacher appreciation week new policy on gifts that will go out. Besser schools are being looked at closer. PArt of the code of ethics is that teachers knowingly will not accept gifts over a certain dollar amount. It is putting the teachers in a weird position. Lewis - Is it a limit per person or per class? Suarez - says it is from a single source.
