- III. Minutes to Review / Approval Grossman approved; Aghai second
- IV. Principal's Report Amanda Evans, Principal
  - o Impressed by students and level of volunteers
  - Enrollment is great; Norm Day is 5<sup>th</sup> Friday of School
  - Fire Drill went well; One fire drill a month; Earthquake drill; Active shooter drill (though not described like that to students)
- V. Treasurer Report Jamie Grossman, Co-President
  - Large purchase of iPads; 40 iPads going to Science Lab and some in Computer Lab; 1 in Kinder and 1 in 1<sup>st</sup>
  - o Rodriquez going to update iPads with new software and apps
  - LAUSD is paying for Accelerated Reader
  - Mrs. Buhai is officially retired; Ms. Palatto is going to be interim after she is processed
  - Lebovic will handle our tax preparation and filing to save us \$4K/year
  - Teacher wish list: Offer each teacher a gift card to buy supplies; \$7-\$8 per childe; setting aside several thousand for teachers; coming out of last year's surplus; Teachers Pay Teachers website and Amazon gift cards from \$175-\$275

#### VI. Fundraising / Events Report

  - Ordered note cards to send out; 60 families have pledged
  - 8 Families purchased 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Tier
  - o Discussion on Corporate Matching; Make it more visible and accessible
- Amazon/Ralphs Update- Lisa Hermes
  - o Ralphs has given ECES a new ID#VP457
  - New Ralph's postcards
- Restaurant Nights- Kelly Kozakov & Lori Gordon Teti, Co-VP Fundraising
  - o McDonalds 9/19, CPK 10/23
  - o Temporarily taking on the position; looking for a permanent person to work with restaurants
  - o CPK in October; McDonald's at White Oak on Thursday on 9/19
  - o Kona Ice is back; Other restaurants on table Poquito Mas, The Stand

  - \$4,800 cash and doesn't include expenses
  - \$500 Baskin Robbins with 20% to school

  - Still had difficulty in getting classrooms
  - o Cheer was cancelled due to lack of enrollment
  - o Musical Theater has 36 kids so a dual cast for Aladdin; extending two weeks

  - o Website is live; Event planning is ahead of schedule
- Turkey Trot- Thursday, 11/21/19- Grossman reported
  - o Committee Chairs will be Jen Meister, Michele Rosenfeld (Incoming kinder parents)
  - In the process of getting donations
  - Looking for sponsors for the t-shirts and glasses

#### VII. Student Services - Sanaz Jedian, VP of Student Affairs & Service
